Dear Parents and Guardians,

Thank you for your emails over the last several days. Please know I am responding as quickly as I can during this very busy time. I do need to update you, as I have been notified over the weekend, that there are now three more students who have tested positive since my last correspondence sent Friday afternoon. The school is in the process of contact tracing and will notify any family whose student may need to be quarantined as a result of these findings. As you know, students have been quarantined because the school was not able to ensure that 6 feet could be maintained in all classrooms from desk to desk. Please allow me to reiterate from the Oct. 9 correspondence, our goal is to have as much face-to-face interaction as possible, and this hybrid model provides the opportunity to ensure that 6 feet can be maintained throughout the school day, both in class and during lunch.

Parents, it is imperative that you are reiterating the social distancing protocol outside the school day as well. Your help to enforce safe behavior and practices is crucial to our school community as well.

Ms. Brunelle sent this to her students, and with her permission I am sharing it with you all. There are lots of changes going on right now, leaving some of us happy and relieved and others sad and anxious.

St. Julian of Norwich, a strong and intelligent saint from the Middle Ages, said about these times, whether good or bad, "All will be well, and all manner of thing shall be well," because in the end, we have to trust that God is going show us where we need to be, whether that's in this life now or in the next. We just need to be watchful and waiting.

God won't solve all of our problems or make life easy for us, but God will give us the opportunities we need to practice our purpose, which is to LOVE instead of fear; sometimes in really profound ways; in other ways, simple and humble.

So if you're feeling anxious, or you're worried that your current sense of relief might leave you (all feelings are temporary), trust that "All will be well, and all manner of things shall be well."


