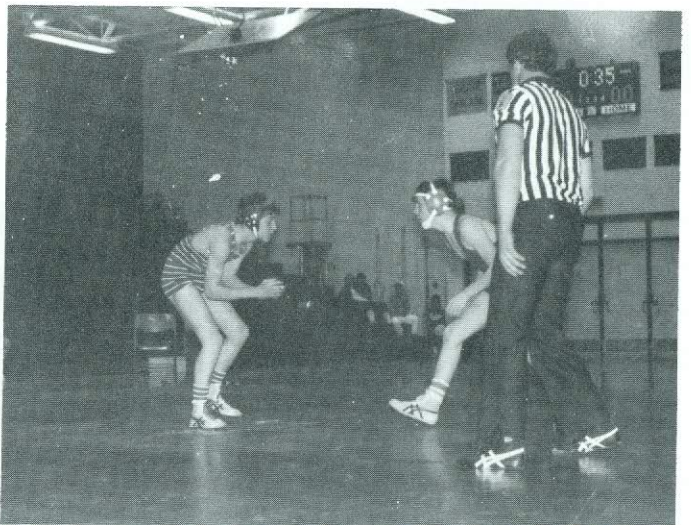

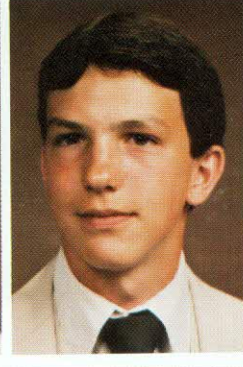
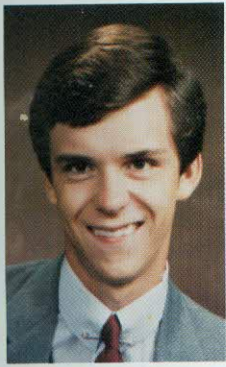


The Varsity cheerleaders went through many changes during their season. But pulled together with the Junior Varsity cheerleaders to make this season an enjoyable one.

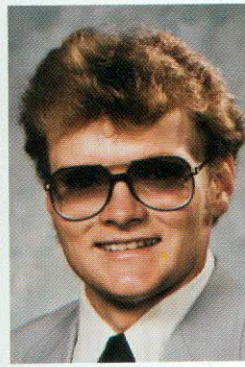

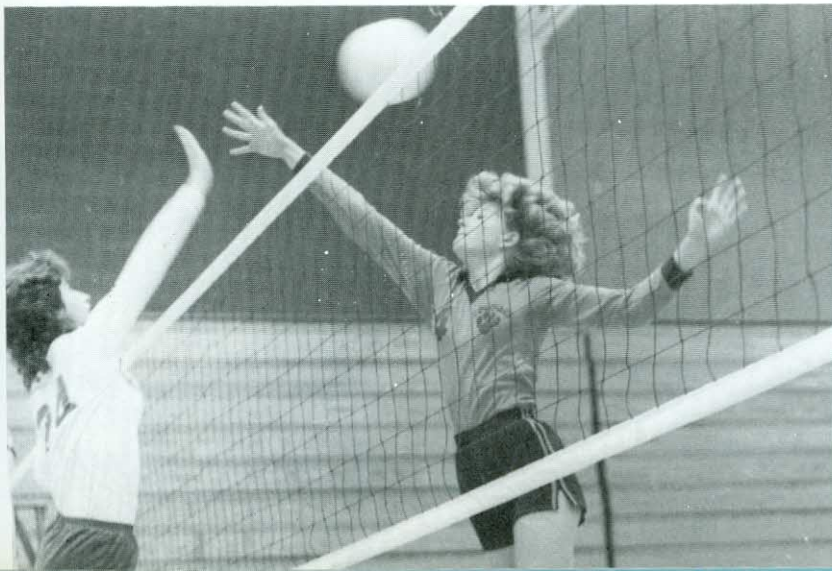

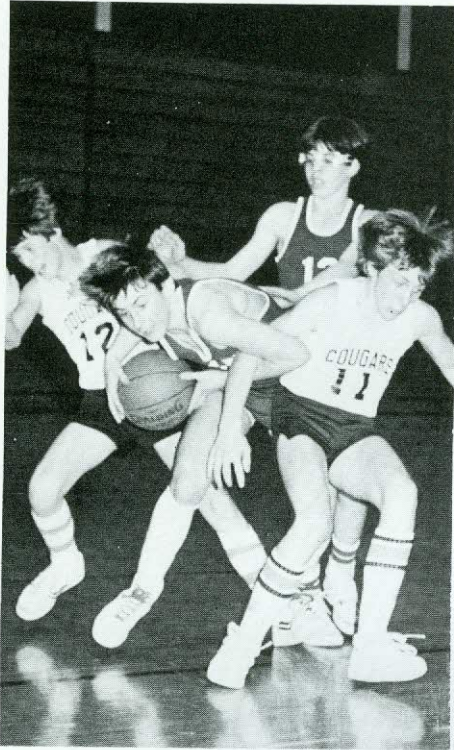
If you were to ask someone how the boys basketball teams did this year they might say, "not so well". The coaches like to call it "rebuilding".

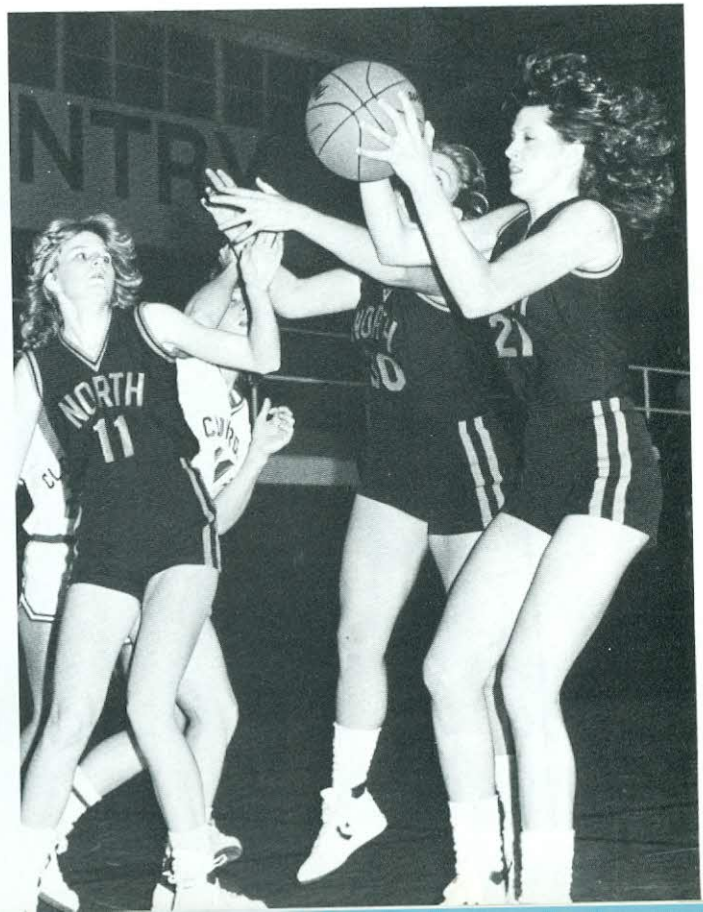
