Seminole Public Schools have been notified of a person at Seminole Middle School who has tested positive for COVID-19. Individuals testing positive are required to isolate for 10-days and will be notified by the local health department.

Contact tracing is completed. First level contacts (anyone who is identified to have been within 6 feet of the positive individual for 15 minutes or longer at any time during the virus infectious period) will be required to quarantine according to CDC guidelines. Quarantine is required for 14 days of last contact with the positive person. All students and families have been notified at this time and have been moved to Distance Learning status during the isolation/quarantine periods.
