WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic during the 2019-2020 school year resulted in remote online instruction due to Ohio’s school facilities being closed and that future restrictions on school operations as a result of state and local health department/government restrictions may result in a continued need for Remote Learning Options;

WHEREAS, The Board of Education wants its administration, faculty, and staff to fully prepare for all possible school operational scenarios in advance to ensure the best learning opportunities for our students and that the application for approval by the Ohio Department of Education for the option of Remote Learning to count for educational hours is due by July1 of each year (refer to OAC 3301-35-03):

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Wolf Creek Local School Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent and Treasurer to submit the Remote Learning Option application to the Ohio Department of Education and create and implement the procedures and school policies that may be necessary if this Remote option is needed.

SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT

Measures are being worked on to get the kids back to school on August 24th. We have to keep our personal opinions aside and follow the guidelines that have been approve by the Board of Education and Washington County Health Department. The principals in both buildings have been working diligently to have a daily schedule for kids so that they can have a productive day and keep them safe. We have been working with staff to fill their needs and we have suggested to them to utilize all the space on the grounds. We have pop up tents available if teachers would like to move their class outside. Mrs. Thomas is creating a schedule for recess so that kids that need that time to release energy have that opportunity. All the above is still a work in progress.

We may need to hire additional temporary staff to do the additional work that is recommended by the Health Department. Additional duties include custodial, temperature checks of students before they enter the building, assisting students when they are in movement (keeping the proper distance), lunch duties, etc.

Additional water fountains have been ordered to include the bottle fill feature. There will be one on every floor of the High School and two will be installed at the Elementary in high traffic areas.

We have ordered touchless sinks for handwashing and touchless flushing mechanisms for toilets. Mr. Travis Wells will begin to install them once they come in. The goal is to have them installed by the start of school.

We are working on have specific guidelines for use of the District facilities to outside groups. This would include the peewee programs.
