FOR FREE BREAKFAST AND LUNCH!**

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has provided an unprecedented amount of flexibilities to help schools feed children throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. As part of this government relief, students will now be able to receive free breakfast and lunch regardless of their financial situation. This extension will help ensure students have access to nutritious food as our country recovers from the COVID-19 pandemic.

Who can Benefit?

All South Central families regardless of income.

When are free meals available and for how long?

Access to free breakfast and lunch starts on Tuesday, September 8, 2020, and will last as long as federal funding continues to be available.

Will free meals be available for virtual students?

Free breakfast and lunch will be provided to all students, including those who are learning virtually. Meals will be prepared a week at a time and parents/guardians can pick up meals every Monday at the K8 foodservice doors between 9:00 am to 10:30 am.

Will students automatically receive free meals?

Yes, however, the Free and Reduced Meal Application form MUST be filled out and submitted to the Food Service Director.

Where is the Free and Reduced Meal Application form located?

Visit your FinalForms account, click on your students forms. Select the Free and Reduced meals then click on the link to download the forms. If you have not received a confirmation email for FinalForms, you will need to contact the appropriate building secretary.
