Dyslexia Program:

During the 2019-2020 school year, Lee County School District utilized the evidenced-based Connections OG in 3D program in small groups to address the deficit areas of students identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia. This intervention program is Orton-Gillingham based and is designed to provide instruction that best addresses the needs of students with dyslexia characteristics. The structured design of the curriculum follows the Science of Reading research, therefore, providing for the students' needs.

Number of Students Who Received Dyslexia Intervention:

During the 2019-2020 school year 43 students attending Lee County School District received dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

Total Number of Students Identified as Exhibiting the Characteristics of Dyslexia:

During the 2019-2020 school year, 22 students attending Lee County School District were identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.
