ORGANIZATION

ORGANIZATION, OPERATIONS AND COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS

Champaign-Ford Regional Office of Education #9 (ROE #9) is one of 38 educational service agencies in Illinois. ROE# 9 encompasses two counties (Champaign County and Ford County) in east central Illinois. The chief administrative officer of Champaign-Ford ROE 9 is the elected Regional Superintendent of Schools. Duties of the regional superintendent are specifically enumerated in the Illinois School Code [105 ILCS 5/3], the Illinois Administrative Code [23 Illinois Administrative Code 525] and Illinois statutes. The Regional Superintendent also implements additional programs and services to meet the needs of the school districts and citizens in the region.

ROE #9 collaborates with the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) and local school districts. ROE #9 enters into and participates in joint programs and intergovernmental agreements with units of local government, school districts and other regional offices of education or intermediate service centers in order to jointly provide services and activities in a manner that will increase flexibility, scope of service opportunities, cost reductions, and/or otherwise benefit ROE 9, the school districts in the region and the community. The Regional Superintendent shall manage these activities to the extent the program or agreement requires the ROE's participation.
