

GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

REGIONAL SUPERINTENDENT – Qualifications

The Regional Superintendent must meet the following qualifications outlined in the Illinois School Code in order to enter into the duties of this office by election or appointment:

1. Is of good character;
2. Has a master's degree;
3. Has earned at least 20 semester hours of credit in professional education at the graduate level;
4. Holds a valid professional educator license with an administrative endorsement;
5. Has had at least four years experience in teaching; and
6. Was engaged for at least two years of the previous four years in full-time teaching or supervising in the common public schools or serving as a regional superintendent of schools for an educational service region in Illinois
