## ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF ETHICS

The Regional Office of Education, in an effort to operate ROE #9 under the highest ethical standards, adopts the following code of ethics for the Regional Superintendent.

In his/her capacity as executive officer of ROE #9, educational leader of the schools in the Region, and liaison between the Regional Office personnel and the schools in ROE #9, the Regional Superintendent shall:

- Observe the laws, rules, and regulations as dictated by the statutes of the State of Illinois.
- Observe the Regional Office of Education policies, rules, and regulations as adopted.
- 3. Support and assist the school districts in ROE #9 in their tasks of policymaking, educational planning, and goal evaluation.
- 4. Evaluate the Regional Office of Education goal achievement with a realistic and considerate attitude.
- 5. Maintain confidentiality of privileged information.
- 6. Develop a communication system, which facilitates understanding between the schools in ROE #9, the staff, and community.
- 7. Welcome and encourage the positive actions of citizen participation in Regional Office activities.
- 8. Recognize that personal values, strengths, and goals must provide the motivation for effective Regional Office of Education management.
- 9. Provide a leadership role model.
