

Dear Wilkey Families,

Wilkey has been informed of a positive staff case of COVID-19, from a non-campus exposure. The staff member last reported to work on October 13, 2020.

Through contact tracing, the Grayson County Health Department has identified and notified those school contacts who will need to quarantine. As the strictest possible precaution, the Health Department has recommended that all students in one classroom and two additional staff members quarantine at this time. An individual who has been within six feet for at least 15 minutes is considered a contact.

Following our established safety protocols, those areas of the building that have been impacted have been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected.

Please continue to monitor your child every day and keep your child at home if they are experiencing any of the following:

- temperature greater than 100.4
- a new cough
- vomiting
- diarrhea
- a new rash
- exposure to a Covid-19 case in a 48-hour period

Please contact your healthcare provider if your child develops symptoms or if you have any additional questions or concerns.

We will continue to work closely with the Grayson County Health Department to keep our students and staff safe, and our families and community informed. If you have questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
