



What is Title 1?


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- Federally funded grant
- Amount of funds received is based on a formula that considers the percentage of students receiving free/reduced lunch
- In-school tutoring program
- Help support for underachieving/at-risk students
- Burr Oak is a school-wide Title 1 School, which means that all students can benefit from Title 1 resources

Title 1 Goals

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- Ensure high standards for all children
- Increase academic achievement
- Provide direct instructional support to students
- Ongoing training and professional development for teachers
- Promote parent/family engagement

Student Identification

- ❖ Academic service to students in our school is determined by the classroom teachers
- ❖ Need of students is determined by systematic, consistent, ongoing assessments and additional risk factors.
- ❖ These include:
 - ❑ DIBELS- Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills
 - ❑ State Standardized Test
 - ❑ NWEA MAP (Measures of Academic Progress - adaptive)
 - ❑ RTI- Response to Interventions
 - ❑ New Jersey Math
 - ❑ Delta Math
 - ❑ Teacher's Classroom assessments
 - ❑ Ability to test out

Exit Criteria

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A student will be exited from Title 1 when the evaluating team determines that he/she is performing at grade level.
Instruments used for determination:

- ❖ Standardized/diagnostic test scores
- ❖ Student's grades
- ❖ Teacher recommendations



Burr Oak offers through Title 1

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- Specialized paraprofessionals and classroom teachers who service students in grades Kindergarten through eighth grade.
- Students receive extra assistance in the content areas of reading, math, and writing in any subject area.
- Students receive help in whole group, small group and individual settings.
- Materials and resources to support learning based on individual needs and whole child
