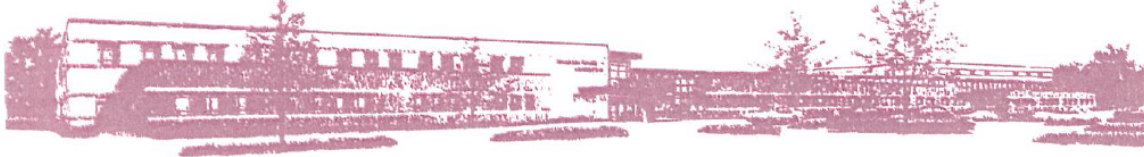

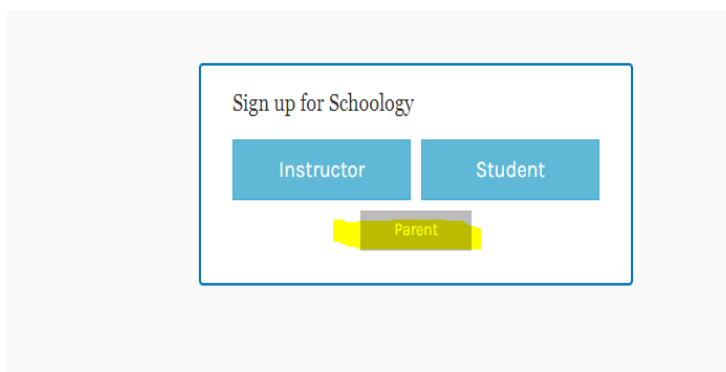

Schoology is an integrated learning management solution that provides course management, mobile learning and support for system-wide communication. Schoology enables students, parents and teachers to engage with learning materials and the school community from the classroom and beyond.

As a parent, you will be able to view your child's activity within Schoology. Use the following steps to access your Schoology account:

- **Reminder:** If you already have a RB Schoology account from last year, simply login to your existing RB Schoology account, click on the drop down next to your name, choose "add child," and enter the new parent access code.

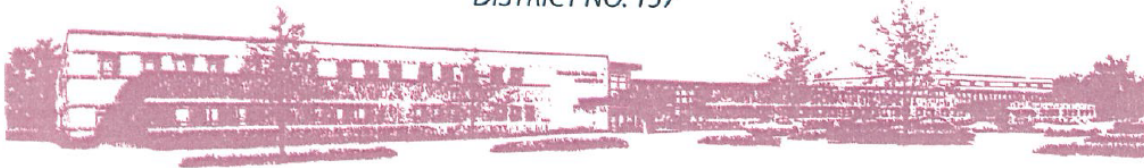

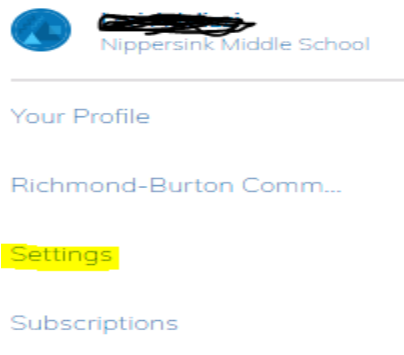

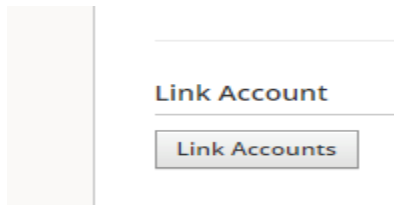
