## **Board Meeting Structure**

**Thank you for joining us in the board meeting last night. Sounds like you all had an engaging conversation while we were in a closed session. Sorry I missed the bad science jokes. I realize that many of you have not attended many of our meetings. Here is a quick description on how the meetings are set. Regular meetings are every second Tuesday of the month unless something forces the Board to reschedule for another day. We post the agenda on the school's website and on the front door each month 72 hours before a regular meeting. We sometimes need to call a special or emergency meeting other than a regular meeting. Those require a 24 hour public posting. In a regular board meeting, we start with public comments. This provides time for the public to make statements on some of the agenda items before the Board goes into closed session. The Board does take your comments seriously while they discuss agenda items. When the Board returns to open session, this provides more time for public comment after the president reports out any actions taken during closed session. During public comment, Board members are not supposed to respond to comments made. From there, regular reports and agendas are discussed, some of which require actions or votes. The Brown Act is a California law that is designed to make board meetings transparent. Again, thanks for your comments, suggestions, and participation last night! If you live in the district of our school, we are looking for someone to join the Butteville School Board. Please drop off a letter of interest to the front office.**

## **Reopening Plan for 4th through 8th grades**

**We are currently calling parents to get hard data on which families plan to return to school with a hybrid model Monday - Thursday. This will help us finalize our Reopening Plan and scheduling. For now, we plan to invite 4th-8th graders back to school starting Monday, October 26th.**

Dear parents and guardians,

California schools are mandated to do vision and hearing screenings on students. It is mandated for first time enrollment in a California school for students from another state and for students currently enrolled at Butteville Elementary (every three years). We normally check students in kindergarten, second, fifth, eighth, and tenth grade. We also check students on IEPs and any of those whose parents or teachers have a concern. It is also mandated to do color vision for 1st grade males. Fortunately in Siskiyou, we frequently have time to conduct vision and hearing for all grade levels in our smaller schools.

With the COVID-19 occurrence last year the state didn't enforce this mandate as children were not in school. With virtual learning, access to students is not presently occurring and it is not known if the mandate will be enforced this year.

If you would like to schedule a time for your child to have their vision and hearing screened, your school nurse Thana Webb is available every other Wednesday. She is also available for communication regarding any other health concern you have for your children.
