



School Improvement Council Nominations for Parent Representatives

Fall 2020

The AFMS School Improvement Council (SIC) is an advisory council to the principal that is focused on school improvement issues. It is made up of representatives of parents, teachers, and community members. The principal serves as an ex-officio member. The SIC meets at least monthly during the school year.

AFMS parent representatives are nominated and elected by their fellow AFMS parents. Any parent/guardian of at least one child enrolled in AFMS is eligible to place his/her own name or the name of another parent in nomination.

Parent representatives are elected to a term of two years. If a parent has a child enrolled in the 8th grade at AFMS for the current school year and will not have any child enrolled the following year, that parent is elected to a term of one year only.

A representative of the SIC will contact all individuals whose names are submitted into nomination prior to the election to confirm acceptance of the nomination. Nominees will be invited to submit a brief statement about themselves and why they want to serve on the SIC. All statements received will be printed on the opposite side of the ballot so that voters will have a chance to get to know each of the candidates.
