### **Schoology**

Students are expected to log in to Schoology every day they are working from home. Even if their assignments are on paper students must log in for attendance every day.

### **Halloween**

This year we will not have a class party due to COVID concerns, please do not allow your student to bring food for the class that day. Each group will have a specific day to wear their costumes to school (see above), please make sure their costume is school appropriate (no weapons, excessive blood/gore, etc) and if they have a mask or face paint it cannot cover the whole face.

## **Grading Policy**

This year has had a wild start, now that we have had a chance to settle into a routine I feel that it is time to address the grading policy. Students will have time in class to complete assignments. If the student does not complete an assignment by the due date they may take it home and finish it then turn it in the next time they see me for full credit. Students have a week from the due date to turn in any missing work, if not turned in by the following Tuesday (Group A) or Friday (Group B) the assignment will be a 0. Remote assignments are due the first day the students see me again (Monday or Thursday), if the student does not have them ready they have until the next day to bring it to me. Every week I post all of the student assignments on Schoology including the paper assignments, if you or your student are not sure they've done everything log in to Schoology and look at the assignments posted in each course. I strongly recommend logging in to Parent Portal to help keep track of missing assignments and grades (students can do this too), if you do not have access please let me know and I will send the request to get it for you. If your student will be absent let me know and I can get their work ready for them to pick up or send home.

Grades will be based on mastery, this means that the majority of your students' grade will come from quizzes and class work. In order to practice those skills to mastery it is very important that your student does all of their remote assignments. If your student is having trouble with their assignments I have office hours every Wednesday afternoon when I am available to help them.
