DEVICE

Shawano School District is supplying students (3-12) with a Chromebook and (4K-2) with an iPad. This device is the property of the Shawano School District. The supplied instructional device's function will provide each student access to required educational materials needed for each student to be successful. The device allows student access to Skyward, Google Apps for Education, educational web-based tools, as well as many other useful resources. The supplied device is an educational tool not intended for personal use including gaming, social networking or high end computing.

FEES:

Families will pay a Chromebook insurance fee of \$25 per year. This insurance will cover the cost of most repairs. Families will be charged a replacement fee if the device is lost/stolen. Families may be charged a fee for loss or damage.
