

## **Phase III Procedures/Protocols – Parent/Student Information**

**Level 3: Remain partially open to some students receiving in-person instruction while other students receive off-site instruction, i.e. A/B schedule. (Follow directives of Governor, County Health and Local School Board)**

### **Level III Plan** (Masks/Face Coverings will be required for all staff and students)

- In addition to provisions listed in Level I and Level II, Level III provisions will also include:
  - Students attending class on an alternating day format. (Students from the same household will attend school on the same days of the week)
  - **Group A** - Students last name starting with A through Lar will attend at school Monday/Wednesday
  - **Group B** = Students last name starting with Law through Z will attend at school Tuesday/Thursday
  - Smallest group possible for in class instruction (minimize numbers of students, however, 6 feet of distance is not guaranteed in all classes and section)
  - Students would receive remote instruction via View Path when not physically in the building – (Live in classroom remotely)
  - Students are strongly encouraged to use their own devices, however, those who do not have access to a device will be allowed to check out a device from the school. Device will need to have a camera and microphone
  - All Level two guidelines will remain in effect
  - Opt-Out students will attend via View Path every class, every period Monday – Thursday. Friday’s schedule for our Opt-Out is below with student expectations
  
- **Live attendance at school:**
  - (Group A) Monday/Wednesday in class at school
  - (Group B) Tuesday/Thursday in class at school
  
- **Online via View Path Program**
  - (Group A) Tuesday/Thursday at home on View Path
  - (Group B) Monday/Wednesday at home on View Path
  
- **All School rules are in effect**
  - All Students are required to follow their regular class schedule and attend their classes via View Path from home
  - Attendance will also be taken for students attending class via View Path. If a student is not present in the class via View Path they will be counted absent and in accordance with the rules of our attendance policy

- **View Path System**

- Off-site digital remote learning is held in conjunction with in person instruction
- All school policies are still enforced and in effect
- Teachers will send out a link to access View Path to all students through either their gmail account, Zoon, Google Classroom, or Google Meets site.
- **At the start of each period the students will log** into each class and attend live from their offsite location
- **Students will spend a varying amount of time on View Path each period, depending on the class and/or lesson**
- **Some students may be online via View Path for the entire period. Other classes may only require the first 10-15 minutes of the start of the class period, which is determined by the teacher each day**
- **Students will be expected to follow our class schedule for all offsite classes – Our class schedule is listed below**

- **Opt-Out Students**

- Opt-Out students will attend via View Path every class, every period Monday – Thursday. Friday's schedule for our Opt-Out is in our Friday schedule plan and listed below
- All school policies are still enforced and in effect
- Teachers will send out a link to access View Path to all students through either their gmail account, Zoon, Google Classroom, or Google Meets site.
- **At the start of each period the students will log** into each class and attend live from their offsite location
- **Students will spend a varying amount of time on View Path each period, depending on the class and/or lesson**
- **Some students may be online via View Path for the entire period. Other classes may only require the first 10-15 minutes of the start of the class period**
- **Students will be expected to follow our class schedule for all offsite classes – Our class schedule is listed above**
- **Opt-Out Students are required to make contact with all their teachers every Friday that school is in session either through, Google Meets, Zoom, and phone call. Etc., or any other method approved by their instructors**
- **Opt-out students, that are not proficient, are not required to come in and attend in person on Friday's, although we strongly encourage them to attend on Friday in person and work with their teachers**

- **Friday 's Schedule**

- A Non-Proficiency list of students will be generated on Wednesday, students will be notified on Thursday on who will be required to attend school on Friday 8:00 – 12:00
- Students who are non-proficient, which is determined by a failing grade in a class will attend school on Friday morning
- On Friday, those students will be required to enter through the front main doors 8-8:15, they will have temperature checks, sign-in and attendance taken, then go to those classes in which they are failing
- Each teacher will record when the student arrived and when they left their classroom
- Non-proficient students will meet with those teachers that they have failing grades
- When the student was finished with their session with their teachers for the day he/she can check out of the office, we will notify the parents, then the student will be allowed to leave
- Busses will run their normal schedule on Friday's and will pick up students at the high school at 2:30
- **Teachers who do not have any Non-Proficient students will be utilizing Friday as a work session in their classroom in preparation for the upcoming week of lessons**
- **Opt-Out Students are required to make contact with all their teachers every Friday that school is in session either through, Google Meets, Zoom, and phone call. Etc., or any other method approved by their instructors**
- **Opt-out students, that are not proficient, are not required to come in and attend in person on Friday's, although we strongly encourage then to attend on Friday in person and work with their teachers**
- Teachers can be available for students who need and request extra help on Friday's. Please visit with your teachers to schedule additional time on Friday's
- Friday's is a time that teachers can use for student's to come into school and make up tests/quizzes
- Students who are proficient will not be attending school, unless requested by a teacher(s) to attend to make up a test/quiz etc. However, they may be working offsite on a school work that has be assigned by their teacher(s)
