

Board of Education
Public Hearing – FY2020-21 Budget
September 17, 2020

At 6:00 P.M. Greg Brown, Board President, called a public hearing to order to provide information and seek comment from the public on the proposed FY2020-21 budget. Board members Peggy Perdun, Vice President; Stan Kary, Secretary; Andrew Carey, Kyle Graham, and Jacob Warford were present. Board member David Bryden entered the meeting at 6:02 p.m. after roll call. Also present were Brad Tuttle, Superintendent; Alan Churchman, District Administrator; Keith Norman, Director of Technology; Debbie Trochuck, District Secretary; and Tim King of Kings Financial Consulting. Lisa Schuenke, Director of Finance and Human Resources joined the meeting remotely. Conner Ashlock, Jersey County Journal, and Katie Brannan were present in the lobby where the meeting was broadcast due to restrictions resulting from the coronavirus pandemic. A total of fourteen (14) people were in attendance in person and one (1) remotely, for a total of fifteen (15) people.

Mrs. Schuenke presented information in regard to the proposed FY2020-21 budget including a review of the funds, revenue sources, and expenditures. Mr. Tuttle added to the presentation with information in regard to the state of the transportation fund and the tier placement of the District in regard to the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) funding. He also shared information from the School Report Card showing that Jersey CUSD No. 100 is under the state average on administrative costs per pupil.

A time for questions and discussion was held.
