Dear La Farge Families,

As was announced yesterday, starting the week of October 19, La Farge Middle and High School students will be shifting to a hybrid learning model. The hybrid learning model replaces the 100% online model previously outlined as the “yellow” level in our three-phase learning model framework that is being used this school year in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. In the hybrid model, students will be learning from home with live teacher-led classes using Google Classroom and tools three days each week, and learning in-person at school two days per week.

Weekly Schedule:

We are still operating on an A/B day block schedule, so the classes that students participate in will rotate on an every-other day basis, but students will always learn remotely on Mondays/Wednesdays/Thursdays, and come to school on Tuesdays/Fridays.

Class times for Remote learning days will mirror class times for in-person learning days. This is a change from our previous virtual schedule.

Student expectations for Remote Learning Days:

- Log in on time to scheduled classes.
- Cameras should be enabled at all times, unless otherwise specified by the teacher.
- Use your school-issued Chromebook.
- Do not leave the meeting until class is dismissed by the teacher.
- Stay focused on class - do not engage in other activities during class time.
- Student handbook policies/code of conduct apply.
- Parents must call the office to report absences from online classes.

Student expectations for In-Person at School Days:

- Students must arrive at school with their charged Chromebook and necessary class materials, and take home their Chromebook and any materials needed for the subsequent remote learning day(s).
- Participation in risk-mitigation efforts required - physical distancing, wearing fabric face coverings, hand hygiene, etc.
