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Comment : We had new activities introduced to students this year. We have had a full time Ojibwe Language and Culture teacher. Our teacher served two buildings and at some point taught all students in grades Pre-K to grade 12. We also started up our Native Student Org and attendance has been good. Teachers were also offered the services of our culture teacher to enhance their specific subject area. We have added resources to our media center for teachers to use. We have also added a tutorial program that our students use on a daily basis to provide extra practice for testing.
