

Homecoming is 10/30/2020 again Clay County

These are the rules and regulations for the homecoming parade as directed by Macon County Schools and our Principal Don Jones.

Ms. Naramore will start taking up money on October 20th in her classroom room#8. The last day to turn in parade money is Wednesday, October 28th by 3 PM. You can turn money into her before school from 7:45 to 8:00 AM, during high school break 9:33-9:45 AM, and after school at 3 PM. Drivers must tell Ms. Naramore who is riding with them when paying.

- The cost of each vehicle to enter the parade is \$10.00. (Only trucks, cars, and tractors. No ATV's, UTV's, or four-wheelers.) All vehicles must show school spirit and BE DECORATED!
- Students will not be allowed to ride in the back of a truck during the parade (*Only individuals allowed to ride in the back of a truck are Cheerleaders, Homecoming Attendances, and Class Superlatives no exceptions. Only one student in the back of a truck*)
- All drivers and riders MUST turn in a permission slip from parents (no matter their age) and let Ms. Naramore know what vehicle they are driving or riding in. A permission slip must have students name on it, what vehicle they are riding in, with whom they are riding with, and parent contact information phone#.
- There will be no Jr. High students allowed to participate in the parade.
- Class floats, class favorites, and homecoming attendances must pay the \$10.00 fee. (*Any student riding a float has to have approval by the Principal Don Jones.*)
- Max of two students per vehicle this is including the driver. (Therefore, max of two people in a vehicle. There must be a seatbelt for each person in the vehicle.)
- No candy will be given out by the students no exceptions!
- Students will have to come to school with their vehicles or floats already decorated. Students will not go outside like in the past to work on their vehicles in the morning. They will be given a limited amount of time right before the parade to do the finishing touches to their vehicles. Therefore, your signs for your vehicles have to be done before you come to school.
- Parents cannot work decorating your vehicle for you before the parade.
- Normal Lunch will be served out of the cafeteria.
- The parade will take the normal route and depart from school at 1:00

Dress up days are as follows for homecoming week:

- Tuesday- Character Day / Jersey Day
- Wednesday- Decades Day / Frat boy / Frat Girl Day
- Thursday - Spooky Day (wear Halloween costume make sure it's school appropriate.)
- Friday Spirt Day.
