NEW ATTENDANCES REQUIREMENTS

For Virtual Learning

Attendance is a critical building block for students learning. If students are not present, they cannot engage in learning. Attendance is a leading indicator of equity that signals when students might need additional support and areas for system and school improvement.

So beginning on October 12 the district will mark absences either excused or unexcused. Parents and Guardians can verify an absence by calling the office (360-965-1900) or attendance line (360-965-1901) or emailing teacher. Phone calls to absent students will go out to families at 1:00 pm each day for the previous day. This will give parents the chance to call and excuse the absent.

Students will be counted present if they engage in asynchronous activities, in place of live scheduled sessions. But students are encouraged to participate in live teaching when possible. We will provide flexibility for families unable to log into live sessions due to internet access, bandwidth, access to childcare, other family obligations, and work schedules.

Immunization Record Requirement

Starting August 1, 2020, all immunization records turned in to schools or child care centers are required by state law to be medically verified. Immunization records must be turned into the school on or before the first day of attendance. This means immunization records turned in to the school must be from a health care provider, or you must attach paperwork from a health care provider to your handwritten form that shows your child's records are accurate.

Your child CANNOT attend ON CAMPUS, FACE TO FACE school until you provide these records.

Medically Verified Documents:

- * A completed Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) signed by a health care provider. Find the CIS form by visiting <http://www.doh.wa.gov/SCCI> and clicking on "Certification of Immunization Status."
- * A CIS printed out by you or another parent/guardian with medical records attached.
- * A CIS printed by a health care provider or school from the Washington State Immunization Information System.
- * A CIS printed from MyIR, which is a free Department of Health, online tool that allows families to view and print their official immunization records themselves. Go to <https://wa.myir.net/register> to begin the sign-up process.

If you are requesting an exemption from one or more of the immunization requirement, you must provide the school a completed Certificate of Exemption.
