Dear Parents/Guardians:

It is hard to believe that we are approaching the end of October. Our school district has had a different but successful start to the school year. This success has been created due to the various members of our school community cooperating and collaborating together.

The First Marking Period closes on Monday, November 16th. As per our district Restart Plan, I am asking parents to consider sending their child back to school in-person following the hybrid A/B Day, one-session day schedule. **Parents and guardians will have until Friday, October 30th to make this decision.** Remote learning students may return to in-person learning beginning Tuesday, November 17th. In order to change your child's schedule from remote learning to in-person learning, parents and guardians must contact their child's principal before Friday, October 30th with their request. After Friday, October 30th, the next check-in point for students to transition from remote learning to in-person learning will be the end of the Second Marking Period on Tuesday, February 2nd.
