Halloween Activities

- Appropriate costumes can be worn to school on Thursday (B-Cohort Day) 10/29 and Friday (A-Cohort Day) 10/30. (Students who attend 5 days are welcome to wear their costumes on either day or both if they wish.)
- Students should come dressed in their costumes and be prepared to wear them throughout the school day. Therefore, it is important that students are able to wear their costume without restricted movement or assistance. Otherwise, our costume guidelines remain the same as in past years, no blood/weapons, inappropriate language/graphics or anything else that would not be school friendly.
- Individual classes may have Halloween themed activities planned. If so, teachers will communicate directly with parents.
- In keeping with our health and safety standards, we will not be accepting outside visitors and shared food/candy are not permitted. Of course, students may bring their own snack as they typically do each day.
