If a student or employee presents, or stays home with at least TWO of the following symptoms of COVID-19: *Fever (100.4 degrees), *Chills, *Rigors (shivering), *Myalgia (muscle pain), *Malaise (discomfort), *Headache, *Sore throat, *Lower respiratory illness (cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing), *New inability to taste or smell, *Congestion or runny nose, *Nausea or vomiting, *Diarrhea without an alternate more likely diagnosis
