WEATHER RELATED ANNOUNCEMENT

The latest weather forecast for Thursday, October 22, 2020 predicts a chance for measurable snowfall in the region. Hopefully the weather system will track south of East Grand Forks and school will not be impacted. However, there is a chance the system could hit the area and travel could become hazardous. If this happens and conditions do not allow for safe travel to and from school, the District may call for a distance learning day for all students. I realize this short notice, but am confident the plans put in place by each building will work well. Students in grades 6-12, as well as all FT distance learning students, are already attending school remotely on certain days and should be comfortable with the process, while younger grade levels may have assignments sent home this afternoon. There is also a chance certain grade levels may allow for devices to go home with students that usually keep them at school. The official school calendar is very tight this year due to the late start and storm day cancellations may need to be shifted to the first week in June. The District would like to give this option a try if it is needed to determine if it is a future option on storm days. PLEASE keep your eyes open for work packets and other helpful information from the classroom teachers. If you have questions, please do not hesitate to contact the school building offices or me. Let's hope the weather system stays south and we can have school. Please be safe and stay tuned for updates!
