Hello Bulldog Families,

As was shared with parents in an email on September 30, 2020, we are moving forward with the planning for a 4 full day per week instructional model for the second semester of the 20-21 school year in all of our buildings. The in person hybrid option will not be available second semester. Second semester starts on January 5, 2020. In order to proceed ahead with the planning process, we need to know how many students will be in our buildings attending school in person for four full days per week during the second semester and how many students will be fully remote learners. We understand that families may wish to change from what they are currently doing, so this email contains a survey for you to complete regarding changes you may wish to make for the second semester.

We realize this is an impactful decision, and we also realize that there are many, many varying opinions about how school should look and be conducted in the pandemic. It's also understood that many factors influence this decision, many of which are out of our control, and that it seems as though conditions change on a daily basis in our world.
