**Hello Bulldog Parents--**

**I wanted to provide an update from our Board of Education meeting on Monday evening October 19, 2020.**

**I also want to thank the many parents, teachers and others who either emailed the Board of Education and/or me or spoke at the meeting. Your input and perspective are valued and appreciated. If you have questions, or questions that that weren't answered, please don't hesitate to reach out again.**

**The Board of Education did not approve the option of going to a five day in person plan starting second semester. The Board of Education also did not approve another option which was to stay with the current hybrid plan with added changes/improvements.**

**This means that the plan in place for second semester, which starts January 5, 2020, is:**

- **Four full days in person for K-12, Tuesday through Friday**
- **Mondays will remain a remote/asynchronous learning day for all students**
- **Remote learners will be taught by Mahomet-Seymour teachers**
- **Starting second semester, Middletown Prairie and Lincoln Trail will move to a 5.5 hour school day Tuesday-Friday. Middletown Prairie's scheduled day will be 8:30-2:00 and Lincoln Trail's will be 8:45-2:15.**
- **Junior high students will continue to attend from 9:30-3:00, and high school students will continue to attend from 9:35-3:16.**

**As we finalize building master schedules for the second semester, we will notify parents in December should the start/end times for a building adjust slightly.**

**Please also note that these dates are Remote Learning Planning Days and there is no instruction or attendance for students:**

- **November 23, 2020**
- **November 24, 2020**
- **January 5, 2021**

**Moving ahead, the Board and Administration look forward to continuing our professional and collaborative relationship with the Mahomet-Seymour Education Association as we work through various issues related to the pandemic and our schools.**
