4th-8th Grades Return Monday Oct 26!

We plan to have 4th through 8th grades return to school with a hybrid model Monday - Thursday. You should have been contacted by either Shawn or Randi by now; if not, make sure you call the office. Your teachers will provide more detail on how they will proceed with teaching both in-person and virtual learning platforms. You may drop off your 4th-8th grade child(ren) from 8:30-8:40, classes begin at 8:45am. Breakfast will be provided for free. Upper grade students will be dismissed at 12:30 after lunch is

served. If an upper grade student has a younger sibling in the primary grade, they will be able to pick up a lunch and be dismissed from school at 12pm.

Note that primary grade instructional time has changed. Drop-off is still at 7:50am and school is in session is from 8am-11:45am to include lunch. School time has been adjusted to accommodate parents with primary and upper grade children to avoid multiple round trips to school. We will now provide lunch for primary students from 11:15-11:45. You may pick up your primary grade child during lunch; just let your teacher know.

Staff will direct you when dropping off students and check temperatures before your child exits the vehicle. Please try to form a double line of cars for dropoff and pickup. Watch for students as you exit the parking lot.

We will be providing curbside meal pickup for anyone that wants a meal. Please contact Colton Cheffey at colton.cheffey@butteville.k12.ca.us or call the kitchen at (530) 938-9753 to schedule and pick up a hot lunch plate and breakfast. Pickup times will be from 8am-12pm. Please make sure you are slightly early or on time for meal pick-up. By law, meals need to be served at a certain temperature.

ALMA

At the beginning of the school year, you should have received an email from ALMA to activate your account. If you did not receive this email. Please email Randi at randi.scott@butteville.k12.ca.us and she will resend you an activation link. We will still send out bulletins and notifications through text and Facebook, but there will also be a significant amount of correspondence generated through ALMA, that will be distributed through email. Dear parents and guardians,

California schools are mandated to do vision and hearing screenings on students. It is mandated for first time enrollment in a California school for students from another state and for students currently enrolled at Butteville Elementary (every three years).



We normally check students in kindergarten, second, fifth, eighth, and tenth grade. We also check students on IEPs and any of those whose parents or teachers have a concern. It is also mandated to do color vision for 1st grade males. Fortunately in Siskiyou, we frequently have time to conduct vision and hearing for all grade levels in our smaller schools.

With the COVID-19 occurrence last year the state didn't enforce this mandate as children were not in school. With virtual learning, access to students is not presently occurring and it is not known if the mandate will be enforced this year.

If you would like to schedule a time for your child to have their vision and hearing screened, your school nurse Thana Webb is available every other Wednesday. Please call her to schedule your child's screening at 530-598-6121 or email her at twebb@siskiyoucoe.net. She is also available for communication regarding any other health concern you have for your children.
