Due to a rise in the number of exposures to cases of COVID-19 in our community and surrounding areas, students in grades 9th – 12th at Choctaw County High School will be fully virtual beginning Monday, Oct. 26th through Friday, Nov. 6th. All 9th through 12th grade students may return to school on Monday, Nov. 9th. We will adjust other campus schedules if the need arises.
