


Quicksheet: Managing Student Browsing


Scenario – Logged into GoGuardian Teacher, you are in a class and have a session started. You want to be able to manage what students are browsing.

2 views: Screens and Timelines

Look in the upper right of the screen



Drop the menu down and select the view you want.



Screens view gives you a tile for each student in the class showing you what the student is viewing on his/her Chromebook screen. Click on a student tile to expand the individual student screen.

Timelines view displays student web activity as a colored bar that scrolls as time elapses. Each student has a unique bar and its color and icon indicates what website the student is browsing.

Commands: Open Tab, Close Tab, Lock Screen, Unlock Screen

Open tab can be used to share tabs with an individual student, group of students, or the whole class.

Close Tab can be used on only 1 student at a time to draw a student's attention back to the assigned task or to close an inappropriate website.

Lock & Unlock Screen can be used to prevent students from browsing and opening new tabs and may be used with a single student, group, or the entire class.
