- Make sure your learner has a routine for homework and assist as needed.
- Read to, or with, your learner daily.

- Encourage your learner to demonstrate respect for school personnel, classmates, and school property.
- Attend and participate in events and programs that support your learner's education, such as back-to-school night, conferences, academic events, and other school events.

- Complete and return homework on time.
- Read at home every day for pleasure and to learn.
- Deliver messages from school to home and from home to school.
- Demonstrate respect for school personnel, classmates, and school property.
