

Wilson College Scholarship Award

The Wilson College Scholarship Award was established by Katie D. Shank, a 2016 graduate of the Waynesboro Area Senior High School and a three-time graduate of Wilson College. The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial support to a graduating senior who is planning to attend Wilson College. The intent is that the scholarship goes to a student who demonstrates high academic ability and involvement in extra-curricular activities inside and outside of WASHS.

Amount: The amount of the scholarship is **\$500.00**. This amount will be paid directly to the institution via the Financial Aid Office.

Criteria for Wilson College Scholarship Award:

1. The applicant must be currently enrolled at Waynesboro Area Senior High School as a senior.
2. The applicant must have applied to and been accepted to Wilson College.
3. The applicant must have a 3.0 GPA or higher.
4. The applicant must show involvement in community service and extra-curricular activities.

Application Process:

The following materials are needed for an applicant to be fully considered for the scholarship.

1. A completed application
2. A copy of WASHS Transcript
3. Two letters of recommendation from WASHS teachers, counselors, or administrators.
4. Letter of acceptance to Wilson College.

Deadline:

All application materials must be returned to the Counseling Office by **April 30, 2023**.

Late applications will not be accepted.
