



CRSFM Scholarship Information

About

The Central Region School Facility Managers (CRSFM) is a PASBO Regional Chapter of facility managers and operations professionals from school districts located in Adams, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Perry and York Counties. Established in 1987, our chapter meets monthly with the goal of sharing information and ideas, supporting our peers, and striving for excellence in school district facility operations. Our chapter currently has members representing school districts in Intermediate Units 12 and 15.

Mission

In alignment with the mission of PASBO, which is to develop and support leaders in school business operations, it is the mission of the CRSFM to develop and support facility and operations professionals to become leaders in the school districts they serve.

Goal

It is the goal of the CRSFM Scholarship Committee to offer annual competitive scholarship(s) to financially assist graduating high school seniors in pursuing an education in fields related to facilities and operations.

Scholarship Eligibility

Any high school senior who attends or whose home district was an active 21-22 CRSFM member is eligible to apply. Eligible seniors will participate in a two or four-year post-secondary school program to earn an associate or bachelor's degree (certified, accredited, approved program). Scholarship award winners will be required to attend David L. Nett Staff Training Day and be recognized during the keynote address.

- Eligible Majors (not an exhaustive list)
 - Facility Management
 - Architecture
 - Engineering
 - Grounds/Turf management
 - Trades (electrical, plumbing, welding, HVAC, etc.)

Award Criteria

For school year 2022-23, twelve (12) scholarships will be awarded in the amounts designated below. Scholarship awards will be split equally between 21-22 active CRSFM school districts in Intermediate Units 12 and 15. Six awards for Intermediate Unit 12 districts and six awards for Intermediate Unit 15 districts. CRSFM scholarship committee members will attend district awards ceremonies to present awards.

Selection Criteria

The scholarship committee will review applications and make selections based upon completed application including submitted transcript, recommendation letter(s), and essay. All scholarship funds will be issued based on the direction of the applicant's school district. Applicants may be contacted by the CRSFM Scholarship Committee for an interview or questions regarding their application.

CRSFM Scholarship Application

- 1. Deadline for the application is Friday, March 3, 2023 at 11:59 pm. All applications and supporting documents must be received by this date.
- 2. Refer below for eligibility requirements and application process for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., current transcript, recommendation letters, written essay, etc.) *Incomplete applications will not be considered.*
- 3. Type legibly. Illegible applications will be returned to you.
- 4. You will receive a confirmation of your accepted application upon submission. Notification of award will be made by your district's guidance department. You may be contacted by the CRSFM Scholarship Committee for an interview or questions regarding your application.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form.
- 2. Minimum two (2) letters of recommendation none may be from a relative of the student.
- 3. A copy of the student's most recent transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- 4. Personal Essay addressing all three topics below (600 word maximum):





- a. The Scholarship Committee wants to get to know you on a personal level and gain insight into your character. Identity and describe at least three (3) personal attributes that you feel are your most positive. Refer to personal experiences in which you have demonstrated these qualities.
- b. The Scholarship Committee wants to know how a degree in your chosen field will help you achieve your career goals. Express how furthering your education in your chosen field will help prepare you for future challenges. Share experiences that have provided exposure to your area of interest. Include past classes or certifications you have earned that will relate to your chosen major.
- c. The Scholarship Committee is interested in learning about your dedication to education and leadership qualities. Please expand on your academic, extracurricular, athletic, employment or family responsibilities in which you have taken on leadership roles.
- 5. A parent or guardian must sign the completed application, along with the applicant.

Deadline for the application is Friday, March 3, 2023 at 11:59 pm. Applications received after this date and time will not be considered. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

All scholarship funds will be issued based on the direction of the applicant's school district.
