



THE BARACK COURT #233 SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS PROCESS WILL REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS:

The information included on the Scholarship Application Form and other required documents must be typed or printed neatly.

- 1. Be sure to complete the following areas on the application form in full:
- i. Community Service/ Awards / Memberships/ Programs
- ii. List all colleges, Vocational, and Technical schools where the applicant has applied and been accepted for admission
- iii. Applicants Area of Specialization (Majors or course of study in college).
- iv. Scholastic and Sports Awards / Honors
- 2. Two letters of recommendation in separately sealed envelopes. *
- (* Recommendations from relatives and extended family will not be considered).
- i. One personal reference from someone in the community, i.e., administrator, minister, coach, employer, etc.)
- ii. One academic reference.
- 3. Official high school transcript in a sealed envelope.
- 4. Biographical essay includes applicants future career plans (Typed <u>one-page maximum</u> Single-spaced). The essay topic is precise.
- 5. Copy of Acceptance Letter(s).
- 6. Professional Resume. (Include: Volunteer and Community Service).

These documents must be attached and submitted with the attached application form.

NOTE: Each application section is individually awarded points; based on a scoring rubric, any missing documents will be awarded zero $\underline{\mathbf{0}}$ points. The $\underline{\mathbf{four}}$ scholarship applicants with the highest cumulative score on their application are awarded the scholarships.
