COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE!

For the 16th consecutive year, the Franklin County Conservation District will offer scholarships for the upcoming school year. **The scholarship amount varies based on golf tournament participation and donations.** Scholarship application is open to all students who currently reside in Franklin County or have resided for a majority of their lives. If you have graduated high school and wish to advance your education within a field with an environmental concentration, then this scholarship may be for you! Fields of study include, but are not necessarily limited to: Agriculture, Agri-Business, Horticulture, Environmental Science, Fisheries, Forestry, Geo-Environmental Studies, Land Use Planning, Conservation of Natural Resources, Surveying, Wildlife Conservation, and Environmental Biology.

Scholarship monies will be awarded each year. The scholarships will be offered to college students who meet ALL the requirements listed below and are chosen as recipients by the Franklin County Conservation District Board of Directors. The recipients will be notified by mail as early as July.

Student Eligibility:

- 1. High School Graduate who resides in Franklin County
- 2. Attending a college or university in the United States majoring in field with an environmental concentration.
- 3. Open to 4-year students Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors or Seniors
- 4. If applying for future scholarships, student should have a C+ or higher average in order to be eligible.

Student Application Needs to Include the Following:

- 1. Application
- 2. Written statement of financial need
- 3. A copy of latest college or high school transcripts
- 4. Written essay of why you have chosen this major and career goals
- 5. Recommendation letter
- 6. Copy of acceptance letter (if you will be a Freshman)
