Dear RSU 57 Community,

Thank you all for your patience and understanding as we navigate these challenging times together. Given the progression of events and subsequent communications, we thought it would be helpful to offer a district-wide update as it relates to operations at each of our schools at the time of this communication.

### **Massabesic Middle School**

As of today: 8 confirmed positive, **there has been no change since 10/4/20.**

The school building has been thoroughly cleaned, per CDC guidelines, following school closure. Staff returned to work at the school building on Monday, October 5th. Those staff who were in quarantine have now completed quarantine requirements and have returned to work in the school building. Those students attending school in person will return to school when the outbreak designation has been lifted. Per Maine CDC, the outbreak is closed 28 days after the last positive test or symptom onset, whichever is later. As of today the anticipated return date for student in person learning is 11/04/20. Parents/students will receive confirmation of the student in person learning return date sometime next week. All MMS students will continue to learn remotely until the outbreak is closed.

Due to the outbreak status at Massabesic Middle School, any updates regarding further identification of new cases will be handled by the CDC directly. This communication protocol will remain in place until the outbreak status is lifted.

### **Massabesic High School**

As of today: 1 probable positive (now determined to be negative)

Staff continues to work from the school building, those staff who were in quarantine due to the 1 probable positive returned to work from the school on Tuesday, October 13th. Those students attending school in person also returned to school Tuesday, October 13th. There are currently no students in quarantine.

### **Waterboro Elementary School**

As of today: 2 confirmed positive, **there has been no change since 10/2/20**. At this time all staff and students associated with the 2 positive cases have completed their quarantine requirements and have returned to school.

#### **Lyman Elementary School**

As of today: No reported cases

At this time there are no changes to programming or operations of the school.

#### **LINE Elementary School**

As of today: No reported cases
