Report Card Skill: Applies basic color relationships to artwork.	
For this skill, students will know: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • primary colors (R,Y,B) • secondary colors (O, G, V) • complimentary color pairs (RG, BO, YV) 	For this skill, students will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • use media such as colored pencil, paint, marker, and crayon in an organized way with color relationships in mind • apply color relationships to artwork • locate/order colors on a 6 part color wheel • apply meaning to artwork through use of color
Report Card Skill: Expands art making practice and technique in 2D media.	
For this skill, students will know: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • how to use/explore 2D art materials for drawing, painting, collage, etc • what materials should be used or are appropriate for a given task • why artists use certain materials for certain works of art 	For this skill, students will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Convey a desired visual outcome for own artwork through various materials • Choose what materials would best convey the desired outcome • Identify and analyze the use of 2D materials in the artwork of other artists
Report Card Skill: Applies techniques to create accurately proportioned artwork.	
For this skill, students will know: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • how to use a ruler • gridding techniques for enlarging & drawing a given image • elements and principles of art • artists that use gridding and elements/principles of art as a tool for creating artwork 	For this skill, students will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply the uses of a ruler to create accurately proportional artwork • Apply gridding techniques to image to draw it larger and/or proportionally • Apply elements and principles to enhance artwork • Identify the use of gridding/elements/principles in the artwork of other artists

Report Card Skill: Creates 3D artwork using various materials.**For this skill, students will know:**

- found/recycled items can be used to create artwork
- Techniques to attach and fasten objects to create secure/long lasting artwork
- Various artists who create 3D artwork

For this skill, students will be able to:

- Create a sculpture using found/recycled materials
- Apply fastening techniques to create secure sculpture
- Apply inspiration from other artists

Report Card Skill: Creates artwork using a digital medium and by using non-traditional media.**For this skill, students will know:**

- digital media can be used to create artwork
- how to explore and research artists using digital resources
- how to archive and create a digital portfolio

For this skill, students will be able to:

- Convey a desired outcome through the use of digital media
- Apply research and inspiration from other artists to their own artwork
- Archive artwork digitally and add to their portfolio for years to come

Report Card Skill: Analyzes how art reflects changing times, traditions, resources, and cultures.**For this skill, students will know:**

- How to analyze and interpret tradition and culture when viewing artwork
- How to find their own meaning in the artwork of others
- How to appreciate and critique artwork in a constructive way

For this skill, students will be able to:

- Incorporate their own traditions and culture in their artwork
- Create personally meaningful artwork
- Constructively critique artwork they view, their own artwork, and the artwork of their peers
