Language Arts – Levels A and B Report Card Skills: Students Will Know/ Students Will Be Able To...

Phonemic Awareness, Phonics, Word Recognition and Spelling Skills

Report Card Skill: progressing in oral fluency and sound/spelling rules

For this skill, students will know:

- Sound-spelling conventions for common relationships and patterns
- Syllabication Patterns
- Doubling Rule and Drop "e" Rule
- Basic Contractions with *not*, *would*, and *will*.

For this skill, students will be able to:

- Meet basic fluency requirements: sounds, words, phrases, and passages in order to read at a speed that supports comprehension
- Manipulate sounds: blending, rhyming, isolating, segment and reverse in order to improve auditory processing
- Accurately read and spell high frequency unit words and sounds-spelling patterns taught in each unit.

Vocabulary and Morphology Skills

Report Card Skill: demonstrates vocabulary skills

For this skill, students will know:

- Word relationships such as synonyms, antonyms, attributes, and homophones.
- Words can have multiple meanings and uses.
- Idioms

For this skill, students will be able to:

- Use word relationships in order to build analogies and improve vocabulary.
- Develop definitions using categories and attributes
- Explain and accurately use common expressions and idioms

Report Card Skill: analyzes word structure for decoding, spelling, and comprehension.

For this skill, students will know:

- Compound Words (no spelling changes)
- Inflectional forms suffixes
 Noun (-s, and –es)
 Possessive Noun (-'s)
 Verb-present tense (-s, -es)
 Progressive Verb form (-ing)
 Past Tense Verb (-ed)
- Prefix, Base Word, and Suffixes

For this skill, students will be able to:

- Identify verb tense based on suffix
- Accurately spell compound words
- Accurately break words down into the meaningful parts in order to improve decoding and comprehension
- Accurately make spelling changes at the suffix join when building a word
- Explain the rule for a specific spelling convention
- Recognize common Greek/Latin bases and use them to help determine meaning of unknown words.

Grammar and Usage

Report Card Skill: uses grammatical forms correctly

For this skill, students will know:

- Grammatical Forms: nouns, pronouns, verbs, adverbs, adjectives, and prepositions
- Basic Mechanics: capitals, end punctuation, apostrophe and commas.
- Simple and Compound Sentence Patterns

For this skill, students will be able to:

- Demonstrate noun-verb agreement when writing.
- Analyze sentences to identify various grammatical forms.
- Combine simple sentences to build compound sentences using *and* or *but*.
- Write dictated sentences applying learned forms and patterns
- Apply learned forms and patterns into independent writing.

Listening and Reading Comprehension

Report Card Skill: accurately reads and comprehends texts

For this skill, students will know:

- Decoding Strategies
- Several Context Clue Strategies to determine meaning
- Several Summarizing strategies
- How to use Text Features to build background knowledge and increase understanding of informational texts
- Various types of text structure and how they support understanding
- Cue words for answering open ended questions

For this skill, students will be able to:

- Read informational texts accurately at increasingly complex levels on similar topics
- Summarize the main idea, including the most important details
- Cite evidence from the text to support their response to open ended questions requiring recall and understanding.
- Respond orally and in writing to demonstrate comprehension.

Speaking and Writing

Report Card Skill: develops and expands sentences

For this skill, students will know:

- Parts of a complete sentence
- Strategies to build increasingly complex sentences to add interest and variety to written work

For this skill, students will be able to:

- Identify sentences and sentence fragments and provide an explanation Identify simple and complete subjects and predicates in a given sentence.
- Build basic sentences, expand them by adding direct objects, prepositional phrases, adverbs and adjectives.
- Rearrange sentence parts and add appropriate punctuation to create complex sentence patterns

Speaking and Writing (continued)

Report Card Skill: summarizes a text

For this skill, students will know:

- Strategies for determining key details
- The Prewriting Process
- Methods of organizing information
- Parts of an objective summary:

Topic Sentence (several types) Supporting Details w/ transition words

Elaborations Conclusion

• Editing and Revision Skills

For this skill, students will be able to:

- Set a purpose for writing and select a topic.
- Pull information from a text and complete a graphic organizer to prepare for the writing process.
- Transfer information from graphic organizer in an organized way using complete sentences.
- Use transition words appropriate for the topic to signal a change.
- Edit and Revise for coherence and content with and without support.
