| Monday 26 <sup>th</sup>    | “Put Drugs to Sleep/Hugs Not Drugs”-Students may wear pajamas to school and/or bring a stuffed animal to school.   |
| Tuesday 27 <sup>th</sup>   | “Use Your Head-Don’t Do Drugs”-Students may wear a hat or have crazy hair on that day.   |
| Wednesday 28 <sup>th</sup> | “Being Drug Free is No Sweat”-Students may wear sweatpants, workout clothes, tennis shoes, etc. It’s also wear Orange Day so bonus if those clothes are Orange.  |
| Thursday 29 <sup>th</sup>  | “Our School Chooses to be Drug Free” Day - Students may wear black and gold for school spirit on this day.   |
| Friday 30 <sup>th</sup>    | “Say Boo to Drugs” Day. –Students may wear Halloween costumes to school. Costumes should not be scary (no knives, guns, etc.) and should allow students to participate in regular school activities (ex. PE, recess, and restroom) |
