MJS Weekly Update

OCTOBER 23, 2020

DEAR MJS COMMUNITY,

Good news! Our plans for Phase 2 are finally coming to fruition. Here are highlights of the changes that will occur; more specifics and details will come to you via a formal MJS update email Monday afternoon.

Phase 1.5 - Our hybrid cohorts will start moving with new schedules and desk shields Monday, November 2, to practice for entrance into a full student body entry in Phase 2. This training time with only half of the school students will allow us room to practice traffic flows, using the desk shields, cleaning desks, and help us get a sense of comfort with students moving rather than teachers.

Phase 2 - We will practice in the model above for seven school days and then tentatively move into Phase 2 with all students in school on Monday, November 16, at the start of marking period 2.

World Language every day! With the changes starting on Monday, November 2, we will begin to offer World Language to our students every day during the period 1-6 day. Students in 7th and 8th grade will also shift into **English classes** for which they were identified, including English 7 & 8 and AT English 7 & 8. These adjustments, which can be made now that we can safely move the students, will not require any teacher or team changes; however, some students will find that their learning periods will shift. Communication about these changes and what is to be expected for students will be shared Monday.

I've received some requests for photos of the desk shields that students will use in Phase 1.5 and 2 - please see these snapshots below. More cleaning details will be shared Monday as well.

HALLOWEEN - we are so lucky at MJS. We get to celebrate Halloween on two school days! We are celebrating this day on Thursday, October 29, with our maroon cohort and Friday, October 30, with our gold cohort. The school staff will be dressing up both days. Full-time

remote learners can pick to celebrate one or both days with us, and the same goes for our four and five-day learners - celebrate one or both days.

At the end of the day students will leave their desk shield on their period 6 desk and it will be cleaned by the custodial staff to be ready for the next day of school.




PTO EXTENDS A THANKS TO ALL OUR COOKIE TROLLEY BAKERS!
