



Good Afternoon:

The Shawnee Local Board of Education held its Regular Meeting Tuesday, October 20, 2020 and a Special Meeting today to adopt a Resolution making changes to our existing opening plan. It is important for you to know the following changes as we move forward.

Effective immediately, there will be **NO 2-Hour delays on Mondays.**

High School students who have 30 or more hours of unexcused absences in the first quarter will return to in person instruction beginning Monday, November 2, 2020.

Remote learners failing one or more courses in the first quarter will return to in person instruction as determined by their building.

Students who are requesting a change in placement (in person/remote) must complete the change on a weekly basis with notification by Thursday to allow the revised placement to occur the following Monday. Beginning Monday, October 26, 2020, Shawnee Schools will implement a 4 to 1 week with 4 in person and 1 remote instructional day each week. **The weekly remote instruction day will be held on Friday with the first remote day being Friday, October 30, 2020.**

Apollo students needing transportation on remote Fridays will need to contact the bus garage at 419-998-8034 to make arrangements for pick up from and drop off to home.

Please also keep in mind, **masks are still required.** This includes while on school transportation. Failure to wear masks can result in loss of bus riding privileges.

These changes will continue to be reviewed and revised if necessary, considering the impact of COVID 19 and the adversarial impact the schedule may place upon some families.

Let's continue to do everything we can to support and help each other as we navigate these new and unfamiliar waters. I couldn't be more proud of our Shawnee family!
