What Can I Expect For an In-Person Appointment at the SBHC?

In-person visits are by appointment only. Call the SBHC number above to schedule an appointment.

- Masks must be worn in the school and office at all times.
- Arrive for appointments no more than 15 minutes early.
- Your teen may come to their appointment alone. If you come with your teen to a visit, only 1 Adult/Guardian per patient, no other family members, will be allowed in the building at this time
- Once you have arrived for your scheduled appointment, you will need to call the SBHC office.
- All visitors will be greeted and temperature/COVID screened.
- Once in the building, you will be escorted to the SBHC and given instructions

Services Provided Include:

- Telehealth (Video and/or telephone chat) visits available daily
- Physical exams required for school compliance
- Sports physicals
- Vaccines, including Flu Shots! All recommended vaccines will be available
- Sick visit (via telehealth or if in school can be done in-person by appointment)
- Treatment for asthma, allergies, obesity, and other health concerns
- Referral to specialty care
- Mental health counseling
- Crisis intervention
