

**ABBA-BR TOBACCO FREE SCHOOLS & WORKPLACE
VIOLATIONS BY THE PUBLIC**

Members of the public who violate the district's anti-tobacco policy and/or regulations shall be informed that their actions are in violation of the district policy. Repeat violation may result in the Superintendent or designee requiring such individuals to leave school property. Repeat violations may also result in the Superintendent recommending to the Board that the individual be prohibited from entering district property. If enacted, such prohibitions shall not violate law and may be limited to a specific period of times as determined by the Board. The Board may grant exception to such prohibitions for reasons such as, but not limited to, granting a parent violator the ability to pick up and drop off his/her child from school.
