

FBB-E- Non-Discrimination Policy

STATEMENT:

The New Town School District #1 in the county of Mountrail and State of North Dakota, supports the provisions of Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1963 and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 which commit all schools to the elimination of discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex and handicap in those programs and activities offered to its students. It is the expressed intent of the New Town School District to provide equal opportunity for all students, free from limitations of race, color, national origin, sex and handicap.

This concept of equal opportunity will serve as a guide to the Governing Board, the Administration, and Staff in making decisions related to the employment of personnel, school facilities, curriculum, activities and regulations affecting students.

COMPLAINT PROCEDURE:

Any student of the District who believes he or she has been discriminated against, denied a benefit, or excluded from participation in a district educational program or activity, on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex or handicapping condition, may file a written complaint with the compliance administrator or follow other procedures outlined in the complaint procedure.
