#21 Cold isn't an explanation for a lack of a season. It just #22 Well, our state's bipolar with the seasons and temps.


#24 No, I'M not bipolar, you are! You're crazy.




the day when our community can sleep soundly. We've been straining around the clock to counteract the forces of MADdie spreading through our neighborhoods like cholera and cankles.
