FFF - Supervision Of Students

It is the intention of the School Board of the New Town Public School District that students shall not be left unsupervised at any time during the school day. Supervision is to be provided for the lunchroom, gymnasium and playground as well as in the classroom. The principal will establish rules regarding arrival at school and will notify parents as to when supervision is available before and after school. Supervision may be accomplished through the use of responsible adult volunteers and/or aides at the discretion of the administration and within the constraints of the adopted budget.

Volunteers and aides who are assigned to supervision have the same authority as teachers in the control of student conduct. However, volunteers and aides should refer discipline problems to a teacher or administrator.

Volunteers and aides shall not be used in an instructional capacity except as guest lecturers and under the supervision of a licensed staff member.
