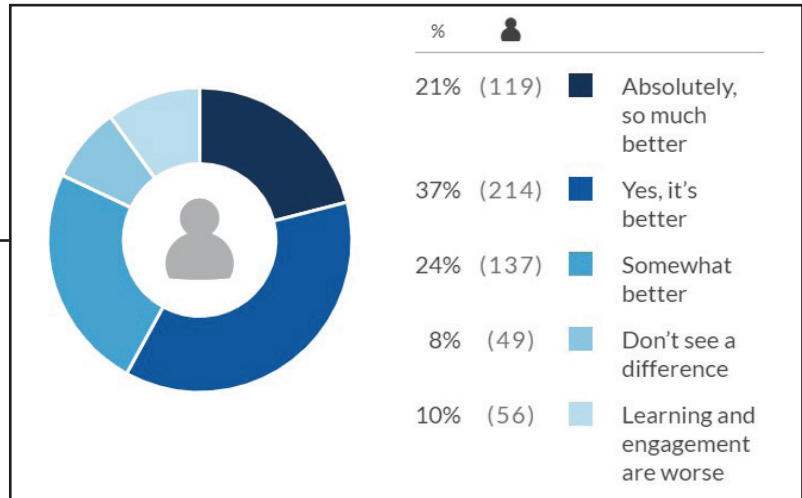

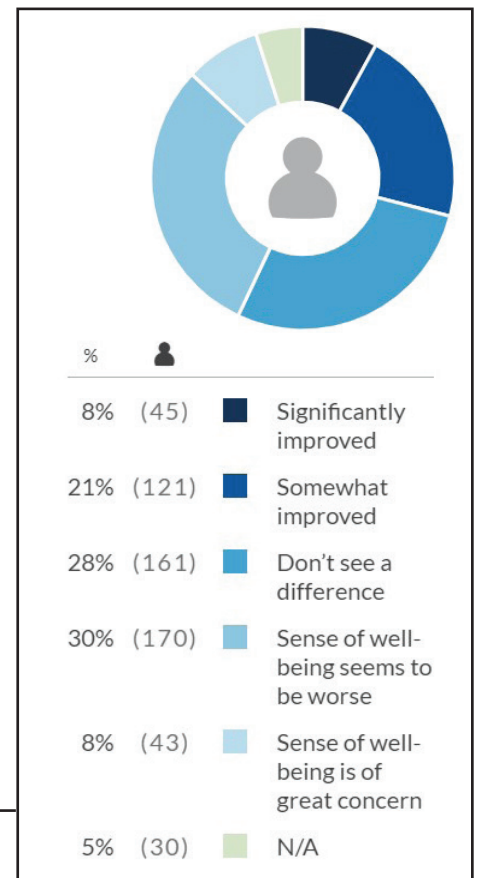

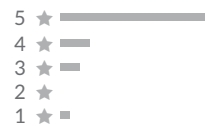

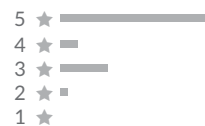
Lack of social interaction Many kids learn in the context of social settings. They feed off eachother, help and challenge eachother. Social "online" interaction is not the same.

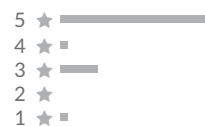

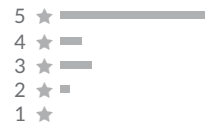

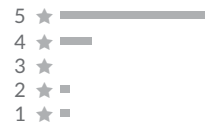
