Dear School Community,

As noted on our website, on Monday, October 26, the health department has confirmed as of today's date, that Pine River Area Schools has at least three School Associated Cases of COVID-19 in a student or staff person at our high school. Cleaning and disinfecting of the exposed location(s) have been completed and we are ready to resume face-to-face teaching and learning.

We are opening school back up at all buildings tomorrow, Wednesday, October 28, 2020, and are working closely with the Central Michigan District Health Department and District 10 Health Department to identify Close Contacts of School Associated Cases of COVID-19. Anyone identified as a Close Contact will be notified by the health department as a part of the COVID-19 investigation process. School officials are also making some calls. Please answer the phone if the health department contacts you, as a contact tracer may be trying to reach you with important information.

We recommend taking action to help limit the spread of COVID-19, even if staff members or students are not experiencing symptoms:

**Wear a mask** (covering mouth and nose) while in public places or if people who do not live with you must visit your home.

**Practice social distancing** (maintaining a distance of 6 feet apart).

**Practice frequent handwashing** (using soap for 20 seconds or hand sanitizer with 60% alcohol).

**Follow MDHHS restrictions** regarding social gatherings.

**Cover coughs and sneezes** with a tissue or with the inside of your elbow and immediately wash your hands.

**Stay home if you are sick**; you can also [get tested](#).

Thank you for understanding that, due to medical privacy laws, we are not able to release the names of the individuals with COVID-19. We will continue to communicate changes and updates with you. With your participation, we believe we can maintain a safe environment while also providing quality education.
