USD 444 Little River Parents:

Due to a large number of quarantined students from one positive COVID-19 case at the Little River Jr./Sr. High School, all 7th-12th grade students will be going to remote learning for this Wednesday, October 28th, and Thursday, October 29th. The situation has resulted in a number of possible exposures that are being evaluated at this time. A reminder that Friday, October 30th, we will not have school. **ALL** 7th-12th grade students will be expected to log on at their regular scheduled class time and to expect a Zoom Meeting invite from their teachers. Wednesday classes will resume at the normal scheduled time. The district will use the time to clean the building thoroughly in preparation for Monday, November 2nd. A decision regarding next week will be made by Friday, October 30th, at 4:00 p.m. for you to plan. Pre-K-6th grade students will continue to go in person as normal.

Transportation for Pre-K through 6th grade will run as usual on Wednesday, October 28th, and Thursday, October 29th. Please be aware that pick up/drop off times may vary slightly on these days. If your child(ren) will not be attending school, please notify your bus driver AND Windom Elementary School. Also, a reminder there is NO SCHOOL on Friday, October 30th.

Effective Wednesday, October 28, 2020, any remote learning student's parent will need to contact their school of choice by 9:00 a.m. if you would like to receive the free meals, (a lunch and a breakfast for the next day). These meals will be provided for the family group and parents will be responsible for picking up the meals at the school of their choice between 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Meals will not be provided on Friday, October 30th, as school is not in session.

Any 7th through 12th grade student will have the opportunity to pick up any school supplies, (laptop, textbooks, etc.), they will need after 7:30 a.m. on Wednesday, October 28th, at the Little River Jr./Sr. High School.
